



CLOTHING

Salisbury Day Care provides a service where children are able to access activities both inside and outside each day. It is therefore vital that the children are suitably dressed for the weather.

We request that parents provide:

- raincoat and welly boots (all year)
- hat, scarves, gloves/mittens and coat (when cold)
- sunhat (during summer months)

It is preferable for children to wear several layers of clothing that can be taken on and off when there is a change in the temperature rather than one thick layer.

Parents are requested to provide a spare set of clothes so that their child can be changed if they have an accident and/or get messy during an activity.

Parents are requested not to bring their child dressed in their best/party clothes. Play here is often messy or very active. Children need clothes that they are not frightened to get messy and are comfortable to climb, crawl and play in. Ideally children should be dressed in jogging bottoms or casual clothes allowing movement.

If a child is becoming independent with their toileting we request parents to consider the clothes that they send their child in. Wearing clothes that they can manage themselves will help to build their confidence in their newly learnt skills.

Whilst we will make every endeavour to keep your child's clothes in good condition and not to lose them when we are out, this does occasionally happen, for example a glove is dropped or a hat. Please therefore do not send your child with expensive designer/label clothing.

Parents are requested to bring their child in footwear that is suitable to play in outdoors. We also request that children have suitable shoes for indoor play.
