30 Hours Extended Entitlement

From September 2017, free childcare will be doubled to 30 hours per week for eligible 3 and 4 year olds.

30 Hours is a new childcare scheme designed to help working parents with their childcare costs, as well as, helping many other parents get back into work.

When is my child entitled to a free place?

If your child's 3rd birthday is between the following we recommend you apply in this period:

1 January – 31 March

1 April – 31 August

1 September – 31 December

Am I eligible?

You will qualify for a free place if:

- Both parents in a two parent family are working (or in a sole parent family, the lone parent must be working) and each parent on average earns:
 - A weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at National Minimum Wage (NMW) or National Living Wage (NLW)
 - Less than £100,000 per year.

He / she will become entitled to their free 30 Hours place from:

The start of the summer term (after Easter)

The start of the autumn term (early September)

The start of the spring term (early January)

How can I apply?
